## SCHOOL DINNER MONEY

As you are aware we have introduced a new cashless payment system in school this year. We appreciate your support and patience whilst we iron out any glitches with this new system.

### Important messages about School Money...

- There are parents that still haven't registered their School Money Account they MUST register before Monday.
- All parents MUST book meals for their child before midnight the day before.
- Reception and KSI children are entitled to UIFSM (Free Meals) but parents MUST still book child's meal for the week.
- Parents can now book all meals up to half term.
- School Money is used for all payments, ie milk (KS2) consent, payments for all trips and donations.
- Before booking any meals please discuss the options with your child, as some children tried to change the option booked this week.
- If you have any problems accessing the site please contact Mrs Teasdale asap, the issue could be data related.
- If you had credit at the end of the summer term this will be transferred over by the end of next week, and Mrs Teasdale will notify you once this has happened.
- Please check your account for any outstanding debt - The reason this may have occurred is that children from KSI hadn't been moved to their new classes until Monday so the payment on School Money was showing £0 but should of been a charge of £2.25.

## PUPIL PREMIUM & FREE SCHOOL MEALS

### Could your child be eligible for extra funding and free school meals?

In Warwickshire it is quick and easy to find out with an online checking form which requires the following information:

- Your own name and date of birth
- Your contact details
- Your National Insurance Number or National Asylum Seekers Number
- Your child's name and date of birth

Once this has been done the parent and school will be automatically updated with no further forms to complete.

The benefits to you and your child are numerous and in addition for every child on free school meals Curdworth Primary School will also receive extra funding (the Pupil Premium) from the Government, which we use to support teaching and learning.
